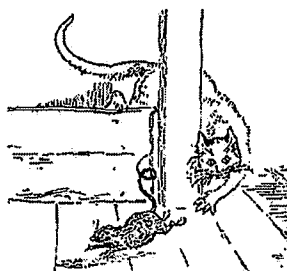

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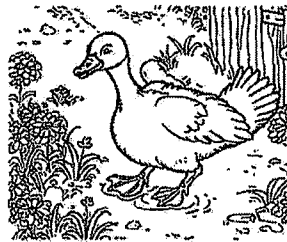

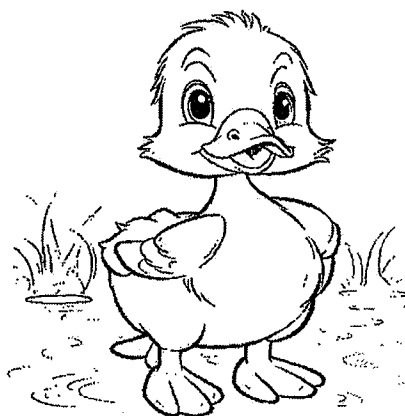

Suddenly, Danny starts quacking so loudly that the foxes let go of him. Danny quickly waddles away to safety.

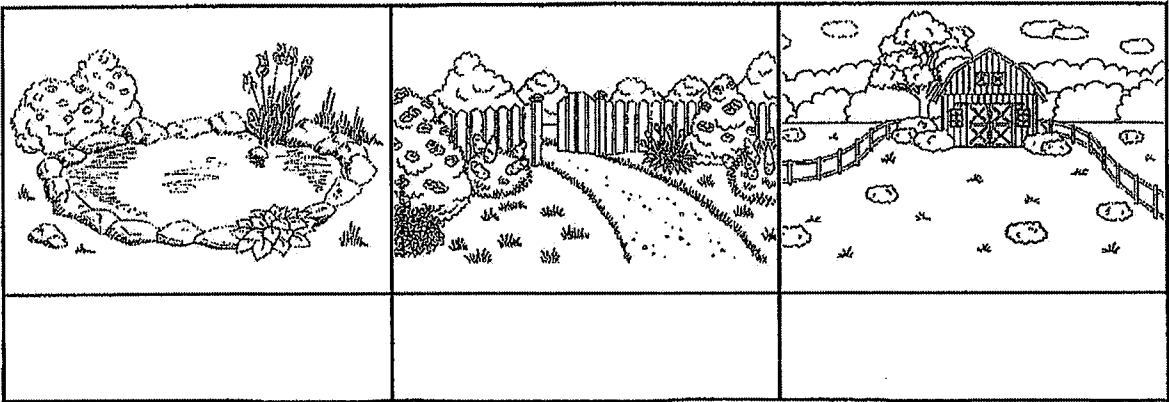

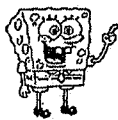

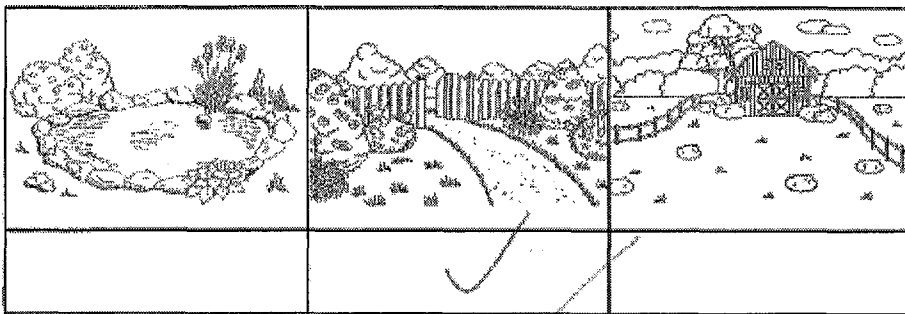
