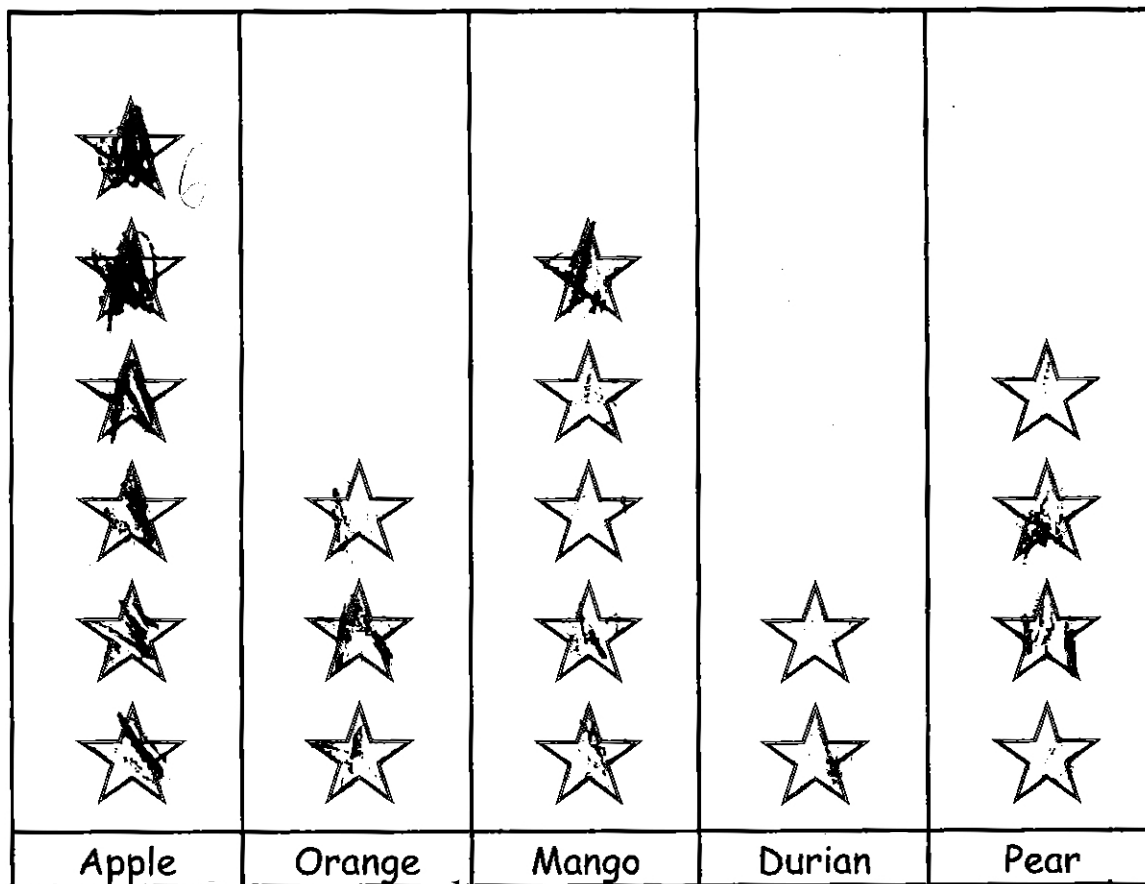
13. The picture graph below shows the different animals that the students keep as pets.

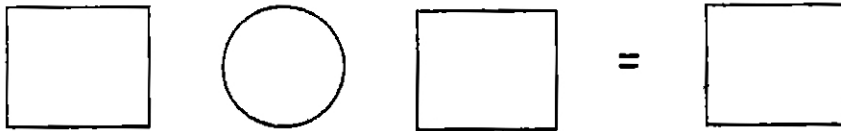
