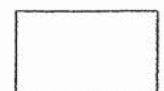
"Hello, Madam, I see you here every Sunday morning. What are you doing with these turtles?" Hasan asked.

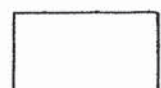

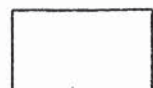
