The king was pleased with the wise man's suggestion. He ordered a pair of leather shoes for himself and requested everyone to put on shoes.

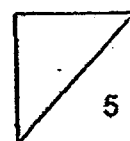

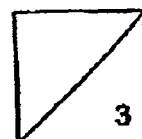
