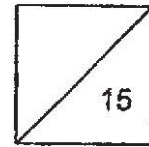

1. Jamle made some observations on four items in her house for a few days. She described their characteristics and recorded her observations in the table below.

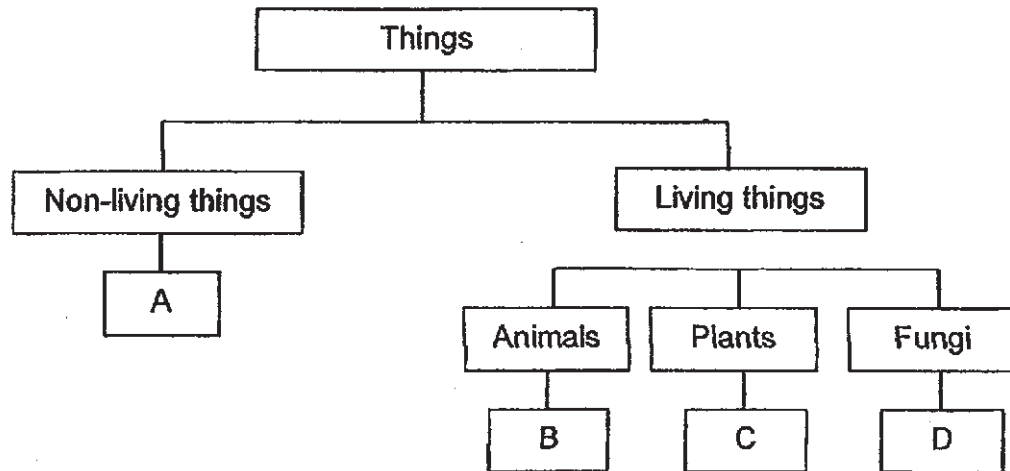

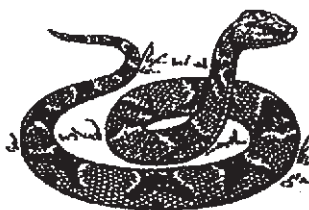

Why did Gopal disagree with John?

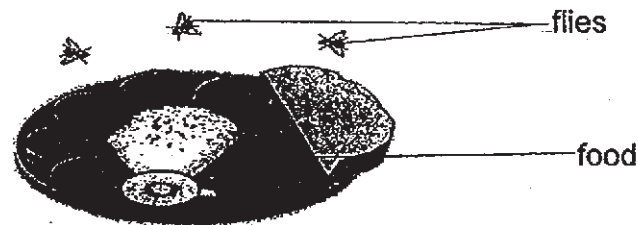

4. Benjamin went to a coffee shop and ordered some food. After a while, he noticed some flies moving around his food.

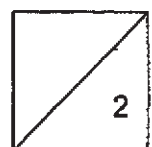


He waved his hands around and the flies flew away.

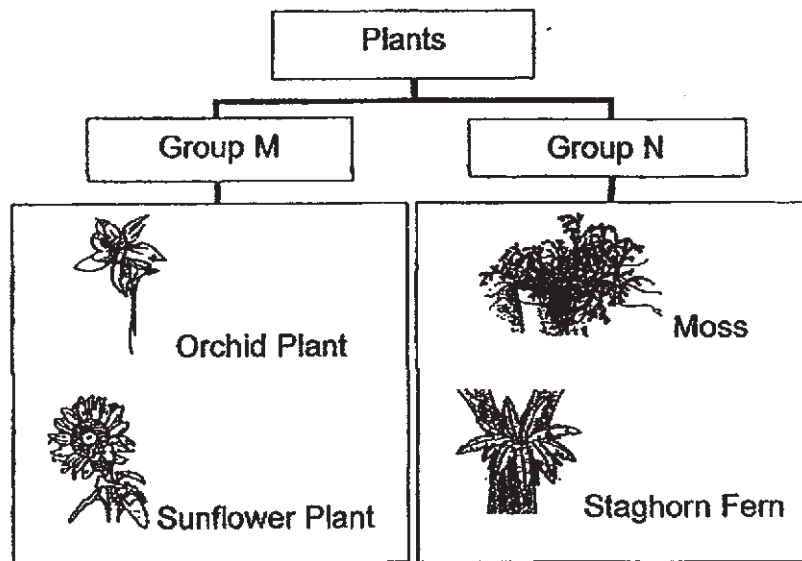
- (a) Which characteristic of living things does this show? [1m]

5. Aisyah saw some plants at a shop. She classified them using the chart below.

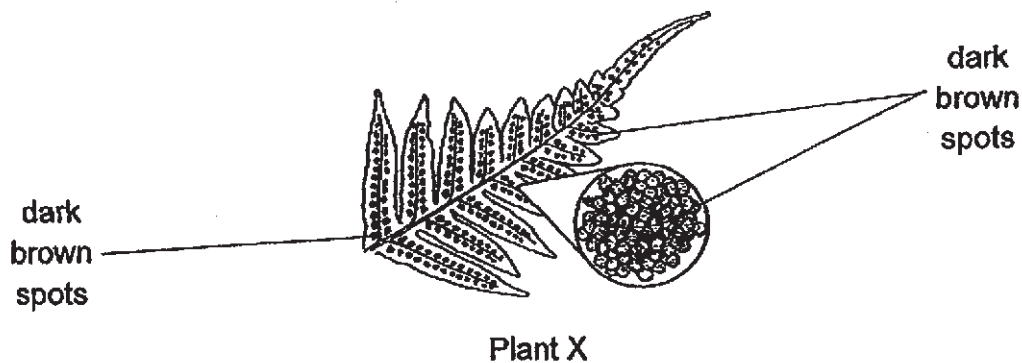

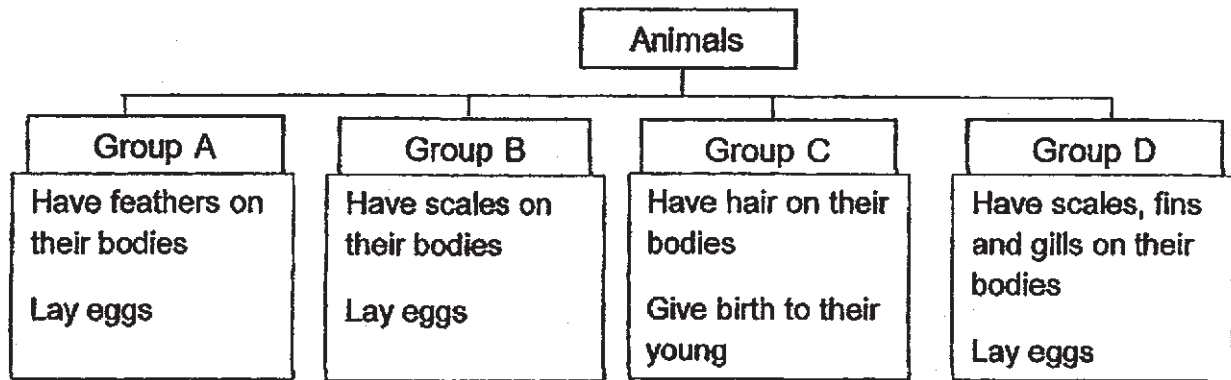
(b) Aisyah bought Plant X and she took a picture of the underside of the leaf of Plant X as shown below.

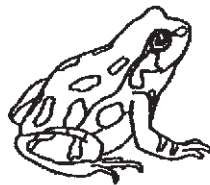

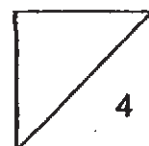
