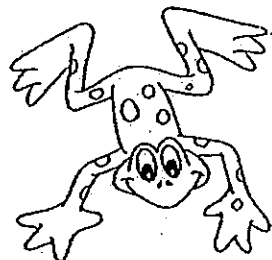

When Jon looked more carefully, he saw two very tiny ears and realized that the head belonged to a seal. 15

The storm was so strong that it had loosened many of the kelp plants a large brown sea plant with long roots that grows in the water. The seal had become entangled in one of them which emerged to the surface of the sea. Jon wanted to help the seal but he did not. The waves were very big and Jon was not a good swimmer. Before Jon could think of a way to help it, Max jumped into the water and swam straight for the seal. Max gnawed frantically at the kelp roots and the seal was able to swim again. 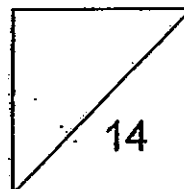
