Do not be surprised or shocked if you see dogs walking around in shopping malls. These dogs are known as guide dogs and have been specially trained. They help to guide the blind wherever they go. These dogs act as their eyes so that their handlers are able to move safely around.

Only selected breeds can be guide dogs. Golden and Labrador Retrievers, German Shepherds and other larger breeds are used because of their size. They are able to lead their handlers or prevent them from getting into danger.

Guide dogs requires a lot of time and patience to train. Guide dogs are trained from young to be well mannered and not cause any problem in public. Their job is to help their handlers cross roads safely and keep them safe. Sometimes, they even help their handlers get dressed. Currently, there are only eight guide dogs in Singapore. Guide dogs are allowed to be in shopping mall, restaurants as well as trains and train stations.

When you see a guide dog, you may want to greet it. Remember, the dog is working and is responsible for its handler's safety. Hence, you should not pat or distract it. Do not give the guide dog commands. Only its handler should. It is best to avoid walking on the left side of the dog as it may confuse the dog. One should never try to grab the dog's harness to control it. You should not give the dog food or treats. It will distract them from doing their job. You should only provide help to the handler when needed. By doing so, you are helping the guide dogs to do their job and keep their handlers safe.
